Councillor, LB of Camden Rising political star Tulip has been called an "emerging organisational creative" in the Labour party and has worked for Blair strategist, the late Philip Gould and Labour MP's Harry Cohen and Tessa Jowell. 


curry industry. He continues to be a dominant figure in the industry and the community


